**Music** – Our music program is instrumental and vocal with a focus on the Orff method which allows all students to learn music through singing, playing instruments, and moving. At the heart of St. Mary’s music program is the philosophy of active music making. Students learn basic music theory, use Orff instruments, rhythm instruments, orchestra instruments, and study composers. Our students experience forms and styles of music.

**Art** – Students develop drawing skills and learn how to incorporate volume and perspective through still life and portrait drawings. They are also introduced to traditional and non traditional mediums of painting, drawing, and sculpture.

**Physical Education and Wellness** – Not only do we offer physical education at St. Mary’s, but we truly have a focus on health and wellness. Our students receive instruction on group participation, game etiquette and rules, and team building exercises. They also participate in physical fitness testing and goal setting, strengthening exercises, and fitness and conditioning activities including skating, basic ball skills, cross-country running, yoga, and archery.

**Technology Skills and Web Design** – Students gain skills and move toward proficient use of Office Suite as well as continued instruction in Excel spreadsheets. They are given continued instruction in Internet safety skills and file management and advanced search skills. Our students also work in web design throughout their middle school years.

### STUDENT FEE:

The student fee of \$100 per class is non-refundable and due with the enrollment contract. The fee covers costs such as classroom supplies and technology expenses.

### APPLICATION PROCESS:

Applicants must also submit the following with the application: Birth certificate (copy), immunization records and transcripts (if applicable). All students will be required to take an entrance test (only the subject area(s) which they are applying) and interview with a member of St. Mary's Admissions Committee.

### PAYMENT PLAN:

Two options are offered for tuition payment. You may pay tuition annually or in nine monthly installments using ACH TRANSFER (Note: The monthly payment option will incur a 5% fee). Annual payments must be paid by August 15, 2013. Monthly tuition will be transferred August through April.

*A \$25 late fee will be added to all accounts with a balance after the 10<sup>th</sup> unless you are on ACH. If using a credit card, any merchant charges uncured are the responsibility of the card holder.*

### UNIFORM POLICY:

Boys – Short or long-sleeved light blue oxford shirt (tucked in), khaki pants or shorts and belt

Girls – Navy polo (no logos) and khaki pants, skirt or shorts
